






Types of packaging


















ECOLEC Envases will be supported by ECOLEC Waste Hub, the managing body that provides services to Fundación ECOLEC and ECOLEC Baterías.

Fulfilment of the collection targets for packaging waste, derived from the producers' environmental responsibility, through the organisation of a system of separate collection and correct treatment of the aforementioned waste.



b.

Transparency and objectivity in joining the system through simple and non-discriminatory systems.



C.

Transparency regarding **fulfilment of the objectives of the system** of the objectives of the system and the possible initiation of sanctioning procedures for breach of extended producer responsibility obligations.



d

Option to change systems annually.



e.

Administrative management of the documentary and information obligations set out in Royal Decree 1055/2022.



f

Participation in the organisation of and access to environmental information through the Incorporated Companies Committee.



g.

Equal treatment of producers, regardless of their origin or size.



h.

Confidentiality of company information



Support and preparation of Prevention and Ecodesign Business Plans.



Collection of packaging waste from producers' facilities, respecting the management systems that, per environmental regulations, may already be in place.



Support for the development of **environmental awareness actions** for the company's staff.





We exclusively pass on costs (separate collection and subsequent transport and treatment; information to the end user or holder and awareness-raising campaigns; data reporting; provision of financial guarantees) according to the **waste actually managed** and each producer's **share of responsibility**, by type of packaging, in a transparent and orderly manner.



Underwriting of a financial guarantee (insurance):

Implementation of mechanisms to return excess revenues per environmental regulations.

The financial contribution shall not exceed the costs necessary for economically-, socially- and environmentally cost-effective provision of waste management services.

The financial contribution, by packaging, category, material and weight, shall be made publicly available.




